Regional Request Stops

Passengers may also arrange to be dropped off and picked up at five additional locations in Prescott:

- Motor Vehicles Division (MVD)

Please call dispatch (636-3602) 24 hours in advance to arrange for request service. Your bus driver may be able to make a request stop without prior arrangement, but only if there is sufficient time in the schedule.

Curb-to-Curb Service

Yavapai Regional Transit provides ADA curb-to-curb, wheelchair lift equipped bus service for individuals with mobility limitations who reside within the 1-mile route deviation zone in Chino Valley and 1/4-mile route deviation zone in Prescott, but are unable to access the fixed route bus stop. This service requires a 24-hour advance reservation.

The route deviation zone for Monday-Wednesday and for Tuesday-Thursday-Friday is shown on the map for those days.

For more information on route deviation for the general public or to schedule a trip, contact the Transit Dispatcher at 636-3602. There may be an extra charge for the deviation. Yavapai Regional Transit will also assit in facilitating your trip with other area service providers.
