Notice of intent to apply for Arizona
Department of Transportation Section
5311 Rural Transportation Grant Funding

The transit system known as Yavapai Regional Transit, a 501c(3) non-profit company, notices the public of its intent to apply for FTA Section 5311 Rural Transportation Grant funding through the State of Arizona Department of Transportation for the administration and operation of a public transit system beginning October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2024.

Yavapai Regional Transit proposes to continue to operate a public deviated flex route transit program within Chino Valley & Prescott five days a week, Monday thru Friday and Prescott Valley one day per week. The total federal share for operating and capital projects is expected to be approximately \$425,000 per year. YRT requests feedback and participation in the grant application from private operators, non-profit operators, and members of the public.
