Non Discrimination Policy Statement

The Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. non-discrimination policy assures full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Restoration Act of 1987, section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI states that "no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination" under any Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. sponsored program or activity. There is no distinction between the sources of funding.

Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. also assures that every effort will be made to prevent discrimination through the impacts of its programs, policies and activities on minority and low-income populations. Furthermore, Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. will take reasonable steps to provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English proficiency.

When Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. distributes Federal-aid funds to another entity/person, Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. will ensure all contractors fully comply with Yavapai Regional Transit Inc. Title VI Nondiscrimination Program requirements. The Chairman of the Board of Directors has delegated the authority to Tom Stultz, Title VI Program Coordinator, to oversee and implement FTA Title VI requirements.
